Phi Alpha Honor Society Award. A cash award to the Social Work graduate who exhibits the tenants of the 6 core values of the social work profession by active leadership and participation in the Social Work Student Association.

Education

John Wooden Award of Excellence. The graduate who represents exemplary, innovative achievement in Health and Physical Education while integrating biblical principles as their foundation platform in preparation for successful service in public and private sectors throughout the world. This award is inspired by the life, career and character of John Wooden who was an accomplished teacher, coach, manager, mentor and Christian.

Literacy Keys Award. A cash award and a one-year membership to the International Literacy Association for the graduate who has shown knowledge, enthusiasm and a repertoire of literature and skills to help the learner unlock the written word.

Mcllwaine Science Award. A cash award and plaque to the graduate who has demonstrated a biblical commitment and outstanding achievement in the sciences, science education and student teaching in the sciences. The student must be enrolled in the Education Program with a minimum of 125 hours of study.

The Master Teacher Award. A book and cash award presented by the Education Department to the graduating teacher education student who exemplifies the characteristics of the Master Teacher.

Music, Worship & Performing Arts

Artistic Stewardship Award. This award honors a graduating senior who embodies the wise servants from the Parable of the Talents in Matthew 20. In this parable, a man gave three servants portions of his property, and upon his return, two had doubled their master's investment, while the third acted foolishly and hid what was given to him. Those who invested what was entrusted to them were rewarded for their stewardship. This award recognizes a senior who has stewarded their artistic talents, time, and attitudes to invest in personal growth and the advancement of God's Kingdom through the arts.

Honor Society Recognitions

Alpha Phi Sigma Honor Society

Alpha Phi Sigma is the only nationally recognized honor society for Criminal Justice. Founded in 1942, it has grown to over 400 chapters at colleges and universities in virtually every state. Lancaster Bible College started its own chapter in 2019. Alpha Phi Sigma society exists to honor and promote Academic Excellence, Leadership, Service & Unity.

Cosma Chi Sigma Mu Honor Society

A certificate and stole awarded to the graduates who perform at the top of their class academically, volunteer within their department, college, and institution, pursue professional development opportunities, and foster community between students and faculty within their program (minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5).

Delta Epsilon Chi Honor Society Awards of the Association for Biblical Higher Education

Certificates to the graduates who have evidenced academic scholarship, approved Christian character, and Christian leadership ability. They must have a minimum GPA of 3.30 or above.

Lambda Pi Eta Honor Society

Students wearing red and white cords signify their induction into Lambda Pi Eta, the National Communication Association's official honor society at four-year colleges and universities nationwide. The honor society recognizes outstanding student scholars in Communication. They must have a minimum GPA of 3.25 for all Communication courses and a cumulative GPA of at least a 3.0, among other academic requirements.

Phi Alpha Honor Society

The blue and gold cords are worn by select Social Work graduates indicating membership in the Phi Alpha National Honor Society. Membership reflects academic excellence with an overall GPA of 3.0 or greater, overall 3.25 GPA in their Social Work coursework and excellence in the application of the core values of the social work profession.

Sigma Epsilon Rho

The mission of Sigma Epsilon Rho is to educate Christian students so that they may proclaim Jesus Christ and serve Him in the Church and society. This is actualized in the Business Administration program's vision to develop, equip and inspire fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ and provide them with the necessary skills to be successful, God-honoring business leaders. Such are the members of Sigma Epsilon Rho. Members embody our program's four educational pillars: comprehension, competency, communication, and character. They have demonstrated great character – integrity, virtue, and determination – and it is for this reason we honor them most. Our prayer is that they continue to abide in Christ, allowing Him to shape and lead them to be effective witnesses for others in the business world and beyond.

Academic Honors

The gold stole worn around the graduate's neck indicates graduating Summa Cum Laude (GPA of 3.90-4.00); the white stole indicates graduating Magna Cum Laude (GPA of 3.75-3.89); the red stole indicates graduating Cum Laude (GPA of 3.50-3.74).

Military Service Recognition

The red, white, and blue cords are worn by graduates who are either veterans or active-duty members of the United States Armed Forces in recognition of their sacrificial service.

Education Degrees

The students who receive the Bachelor of Science in Education degree will also be eligible for teaching certificates from the Pennsylvania Department of Education and the Association of Christian Schools International.

The graduates who are unable to attend this Commencement will graduate in absentia and their names will not be read. This program does not constitute the official record of Lancaster Bible College's 2025-2026 graduates, though the listing was as accurate as possible at the time of publication. The official record of graduates is kept in the Registrar's Office.

Academic Regalia

Academic regalia of gown and hood are believed to have had their beginnings at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries. The hoods are a carryover from the times when the clergy who operated the universities wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter or to collect alms when worn as shoulder capes.

While originating from medieval times, academic attire has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any trappings of rank or social standing underneath. Gowns are usually designed with pointed sleeves for the bachelor's degree; long, closed sleeves with a slit at the arm or wrist for the master's degree; and full bell double sleeves for the doctor's degree. Bachelor's and master's degree gowns have no trimming. For the doctor's degree, the gown has velvet edging down the front and three bars of velvet across each sleeve in the color representative of the academic major or degree.

Most gowns are the traditional black; a different colored gown worn by a faculty member indicates the color of the college or university from which the faculty member graduated.

Academic caps in North America are usually the mortarboard style for all degrees. The cap for the doctor's degree may be made of velvet and may have a gold tassel instead of the color usually worn to represent the academic discipline. In place of the mortarboard, some North American colleges and universities have adopted the European style cap, which is called a tam.

Presidential Medallion

A medallion or seal of office worn by the head of an educational institution is a practice that also dates to the Middle Ages. In those times, a seal was used to mark documents as official. Wearing the seal eventually became a symbol of authority. The presidential medallion of Lancaster Bible College is a cast of the College Seal, incorporating a Conestoga wagon, an open Bible, and the College verse: "The Word of the Lord endures forever." (1 Peter 1:25). The Conestoga wagon reflects the historical heritage of Lancaster County and represents sending forth spiritual pioneers and laborers from LBC. Behind the Conestoga wagon is the open Bible, signifying that the Word of God is the foundation of LBC, as is also indicated by the College verse.

Servant's Towel

Since 1933, servant leadership has been the culture of Lancaster Bible College. The mission of LBC is to educate Christian students to think and live a biblical worldview and to proclaim Christ by serving Him in the Church and society. Christ was the ultimate example of servanthood, as God Incarnate willingly humbled Himself by taking the form of a man.

On the night He was betrayed, Jesus took not only the bread and the cup as lasting symbols of His self-giving love, but also a servant's towel. He stepped down from the seat of honor, took off His outer clothing, put a towel around His waist and washed His disciples' feet. In so doing, He offered them a profound and radically counter-culture demonstration of the very heart of God. The joy-filled life in which He invites His followers to participate involves taking up the towel with Him.

The servant's towel is more than a symbol at LBC. It is a tangible expression of our mission, reminding graduates that everything they have accomplished and will accomplish comes by participating in the servant ministry of Jesus Christ.

The servant's towel is reminiscent of the emphasis placed, throughout students' LBC experience, on serving one another in love. Today, our graduates receive not only academic degrees, but also towels as they embark on a new phase of their servant ministry to the Church and society. The servant's towel contains a printed reminder of Jesus' ministry to His disciples. Our prayer is that our graduates will accept the challenge to follow Christ's example of servant leadership.

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The scarlet trustee gowns are emblazoned with scarlet facing panels and rouge sleeves trimmed in white braid. The hood features the satin red and white colors of Lancaster Bible College. The scarlet, velvet, and eight-sided doctoral tam is a departure from the usual mortarboard and is similar to those used by certain European universities and by some other American institutions to denote trustee rankings. These gowns add to the significance of this occasion and represent the dedication and support of the Board of Trustees of Lancaster Bible College.

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Lancaster Bible College is a premier academic institution that provides an accredited university-level education for multiple careers with a focus on the Bible and a biblical worldview, Christ and Christian character. LBC offers a full range of collegiate programming from non-credit biblical enrichment courses to associate, bachelor's, master's and doctoral degree programs. Since 1933, LBC has prepared both on-campus students and online students to proclaim Christ by serving Him in the Church and society. Our promise is to "prepare students to flourish in college and life, inside and outside the classroom, from the conviction that Christ is real and the Bible is true." Our graduates are geographically and culturally diverse, serving as leaders in professional and ministry settings worldwide.

Accredited through the Middle States Commission on Higher Education and the Association for Biblical Higher Education Commission on Accreditation, LBC is also approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Education. Specialized accreditations include: Council on Social Work Education; National Association of Schools of Music; Commission on Sport Management Accreditation and Association of Christian School International.

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
